Ordinary members must be over 18 years of age - each membership carries 1 vote in matters of the station - the rates shown below are annual fees. The 3 voting memberships are.....

Ordinary membership - \$5.00 per individual

Life membership - these memberships are only awarded from time to time and are given free of charge

Corporate membership - \$50.00 for clubs & non-profit organisations
- \$100.00 for commercial organisations

Auxiliary membership is a special free of charge category of non-voting memberships to encompass carers and children under 18yrs. An auxiliary member is bound by the same rules of behaviour as a member. If any ordinary member has a carer then that carer must submit an application form and can choose to either pay the \$5 membership fee and become an ordinary member or not pay the membership fee and become a non-voting auxiliary member.

Once you have signed this application and made full payment of the membership fee, (by cash handed to a committee member or by direct debit into our account – Dalby Broadcasting Association, Heritage Bank, BSB 638 070 A/C 4664574S21 (please state your name as the reference), your application will be put to the next management committee for consideration. Once your application has been accepted by the management committee you will be given a membership pack containing the rules of the station and the station's constitution (both of which are available to you before you apply if you would prefer). Active volunteers are required to hold a current Blue Card (and if you don't already hold one, we can help organise it for you).

After your application has been accepted and before you can participate in any activities at the station volunteers you will need to undergo a workplace health and safety induction of the station. If for any reason your membership is not accepted then your membership fee will be returned to you immediately. Please note that Dalby Broadcasting Association Inc holds a current \$10m public liability insurance policy.

The questions below are intended more for those who want to become active volunteers than for those who just want to support the station by being a non-volunteer member. Having said that, we would love it if everyone answered them. They are designed to help us make your membership more enjoyable and more meaningful.
